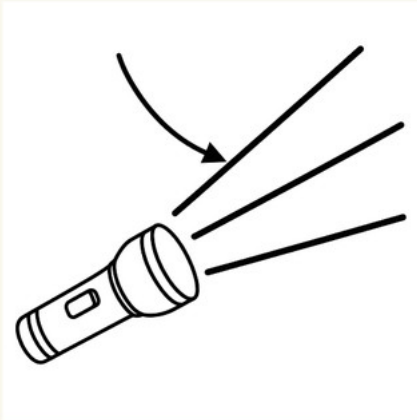

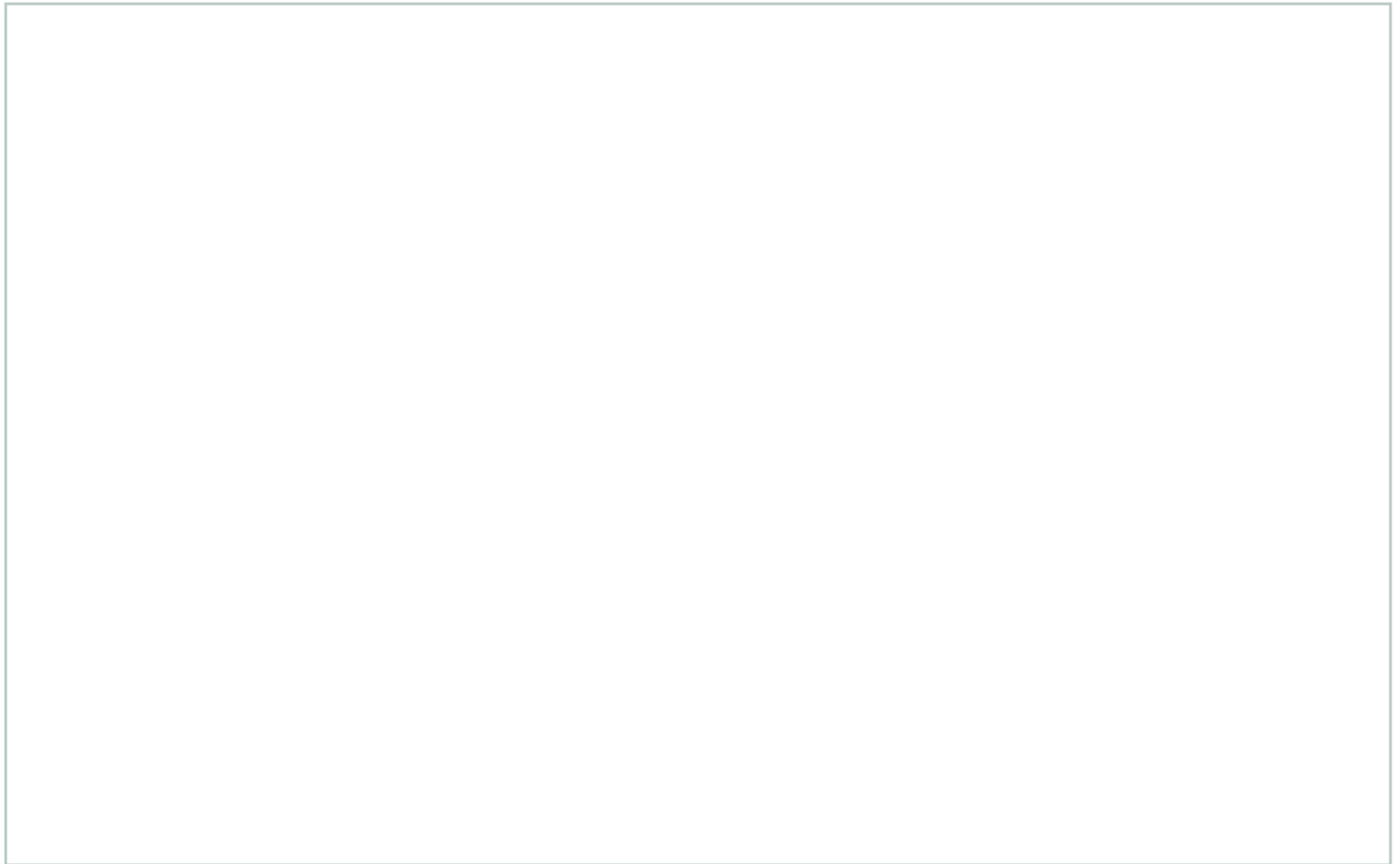

Directions and differentiation

Worksheet page 5 · My favorite story moment

Choose a day and draw an appropriate memory cue. Dictate or write a reason. Any day is welcome if the explanation fits the story. A Shabbat family custom should be described as a present-day reminder, not a creation on day seven.

Younger: point to a deck picture and tell an adult about it. Older: add two accurate details and a verse reference.

Answer guidance

Any day is welcome if the child's explanation fits the creation story. A plant fits day three; a bird fits day five. A Shabbat family custom can be a modern memory cue for rest. Accept spoken, dictated, or drawn responses.

Another included activity: day-picture matching (worksheet page 2)

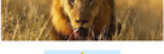

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Know exactly what is included

Format

Instant digital files. Two editable 14-slide PPTX decks, an editable eight-page worksheet PPTX, PDF copies, teaching guides, answers, scope, and credits. Nothing physical is shipped.

Hebrew support

The English route includes English notes, worksheet directions, oral choices, and answers. Hebrew slides and Hebrew teacher scripts are for adults who read Hebrew. Selected words and the opening verse have pronunciation aids.

Print and use

Worksheets are US Letter. Print at Actual Size / 100%, choosing only the pages you need. Photographs and teaching illustrations use color; no low-ink promise is made. One cover plus seven activity pages is eight worksheet-pack pages in total.

Scope and license

The creation-and-Shabbat sequence is Genesis 1:1–2:3, with a practical connection to Genesis 2:15. This is not the whole parashah. Original educational materials are licensed for one family; underlying photo licenses remain available as credited.

Preparation

Read the parent guide and choose an activity. The supplied 30-minute plan is flexible. No Hebrew fluency is required to use the English route; the full Hebrew deck is not transliterated. No audio or physical materials are included.
